Bid Evaluation Criteria (BEC)

<u>Technical Criteria</u> (as a single bidder)

Bidder shall have experience of having executed at least a single order/contract of "similar Work" of any Government / Semi-Government / PSU/ CGD/ MNC/ Pvt. Company of minimum ₹ 13.98 Lacs of the value of work in any one of the previous 7 years before the due date of bid submission.

"Similar Work" shall mean supply of manpower for Support/ Peripheral/ Allied/ Revenue, Operation and maintenance, Para Medical services excluding Security Services.

Bidder is required to submit detailed WO/LOA/LOI along with a detailed Schedule of Rates and its Completion Certificate/execution certificate/ Client Certificate in documentary proof duly certified/attested by the notary public and charted engineer.

The document submitted to technical BEC should be duly certified/ attested by the notary public and charted engineer

Document Required

The Completion Certificate/Execution Certificate/ Client Certificate Clearly showing:

- a. Bidder Name and address, relevant WO/LOA/LOI No. with authorized signatory on end-user letterhead.
- b. Awarded value and actual executed order value.
- c. Date of actual commencement of contract and date of actual completion of contract.

<u>Financial Criteria (as a single bidder)</u>

Annual Turn Over of the bidder should be a minimum of \gtrless 55,01,110.00 in any one of the preceding three financial years.

The net worth of the bidder should be positive as per the last audited financial statement.

The Working Capital of the Bidder should be a minimum of ₹ 11,00,222.00 as per the last audited financial year.

<u>Annual Turnover</u> – In case the tenders have the bid closing date up to 31st September (or as amended from time to time by the Government) of the relevant financial year, and audited financial results of immediate 3 preceding financial years are not available, the bidder has the option to submit the audited financial results of the 3 years immediately before that. Wherever the closing date of the bid is after 31st September (or as amended from time to time by the Government) of the relevant financial year, the bidder has to compulsorily submit the audited financial results for the immediate 3 preceding financial years.

<u>Net worth and Working Capital</u> –In case the tenders having the bid closing date upto 31st September (or as amended from time to time by the Government) of the relevant financial year, and audited financial results of the immediately preceding financial year are not available, in such a case the audited financial results of the year immediately before that year will be considered as last financial year for Net worth/ Working Capital calculation. Wherever the closing date of the bid is after 31st September (or as amended from time to time by the Government) of the relevant financial year, the bidder has to compulsorily submit the audited financial result for the immediately preceding financial year._If the bidder's working capital is negative or inadequate, the bidder shall submit a letter from their bank having a net worth not less than ₹ 100 crores, confirming the availability of a line of credit for at least the working capital requirement as stated above. The line of credit letter from the bank is to be submitted strictly as per the format of F-15.

(A) <u>Authentication of Documents to be Submitted in Support of BEC</u>

(i) <u>Technical Criteria of BEC</u>

All documents in support of the Technical Criteria of BEC to be furnished by the Bidder shall necessarily be duly certified/ attested by a Chartered Engineer and Notary Public with a legible stamp.

(ii) Financial Criteria of BEC

Bidder shall submit "Details of financial capability of Bidder" in the prescribed format (F-16) duly signed and stamped by a chartered accountant/ Certified Public Accountant (CPA).

Further, a copy of audited annual financial statements submitted in the bid shall be duly certified/ attested by Notary Public with a legible stamp

Apart from the above, the Bidder must submit all other relevant documents/ information as specified in the Scope of Work/ SCC for Technical Evaluation of a bid or specified elsewhere in the Tender Document, towards proof of its responsiveness.
